Bases for calculating reproduction fees for the vector map files of the EurAtlas® Periodical Historical Atlas of Europe.

The maps of the Periodical Historical Atlas of Europe cover the Earth's surface from the 15th degree west to the 50th degree east, and from the 20th degree north to the 60th degree north. They describe the political situation of this area as if the first day of the last year of each century of the Christian Era. The first map is that of the Year 1, and the following twenty are increased by 100 up to the year 2000.

Each map is available in CorelDraw 8® or Adobe Illustrator® vector format and consists of 8 layers or main maps:

1 Countries: drawn coloured surfaces depicting the countries. The polygons of the countries having an ocean side extend under the ocean surfaces of Map 2. Only the land parts of the contours are drawn contiguously. Dependent countries, or those whose borders are imprecise, form complex vector objects called "form shadings." The user can easily modify or suppress these shadings.

2 Seas: drawing of sea and lake surfaces, i.e., of coasts, in 6 main vector objects. The colour of the lakes or of the North Sea can thus be changed without touching the Mediterranean. This bottom layer is relatively homogeneous regardless of the century considered, but there are four main forms: for the years 1 to 700, for the years 800 to 1400, and for modern times. The 2000 layer has additional artificial land surfaces and lakes.

3 Rivers: polygonal lines represent the main courses of water in the area described. With the exception of a few details (Suez Canal, for example), this layer is the same for all maps.

4 Cities: small circles accompanied by names in 1-point font mark the sites of the main cities existing in the century in question. The names, given in the local language, vary according to era, going from Latin to the Medieval and then the modern languages. There are about 1000 place names for the ancient maps, and this number increases progressively to 2,550 for the year 2000.

5 Provincial borders: polygonal lines mark the internal administrative borders of the main countries.

6 Country borders: polygonal lines mark the borders of countries as well as the major administrative divisions like regions or Roman dioceses. Most of the borders can easily be reconstituted from Layer 1 "Countries".

7 Names: names of countries, divisions and subdivisions of countries or peoples in the regions with no clear public authority. There are about 150 place names for the ancient maps, and this number increases progressively to 1070 for the map for the year 2000. Texts are in Latin up until the year 500, and in French or English, your choice, for the following centuries.

8 Coordinates: this layer has the latitude and longitude lines for the zone described, with an increment of 5. A second layer is offered free of charge including all latitudes and longitudes, with a precision of half a degree.

Layers 5 and 6 cannot be purchased alone. The colours of Layer 1 "Countries" follow a certain system. Buyer is not required to maintain it, but if he buys 6 century maps or more, the complete list of colours will be provided free of charge. Each layer includes an undetectable digital signature.

Price list for commercial use

Principle of remuneration in the form of an initial fixed price accompanies by royalties due upon actual publication of the work. The reference rates below take into account the layers utilised.

For calculating the royalties in the case of paid multimedia presentations on a screen, 20 admission tickets before tax equal the price of one work.

*The base price for each layer is reduced by € 1 for each additional year. The second year of layer 1 costs € 29, the third € 28, and so on. The maximum reduction for a complete year map is € 8.
